

## 6 Week Course | November 6 – December 15, 2023

The Saskatoon Trades & Skills Centre (STSC) is pleased to offer a 6-week Warehouse course that will give you the basic skills required to gain employment within the field. You will work closely with job coaches and certified instructors to grow your knowledge base and complete the prerequisite training and certificates to ensure employment at the end of six weeks. As a warehouse worker you will work in a physical and fast-paced environment in any business that stores and processes orders of products. You will be responsible for loading materials for shipping and unloading products from incoming shipments. Organization will be key in keeping track of inventory of incoming and outgoing products. You will gain the skills you need to confidently and safely operate specialty machinery designed to aid in the transport of heavy materials like forklifts or ladders. (NOC 14401)

- A minimum language level of **CLB Level 5 in all four categories** (reading, writing, listening, speaking) *\*For applicants with English as a second language\* Must be a Permanent resident to apply.*
- Must be able to work evenings and weekends.
- Valid Class 5 Driver's license is preferred.
- A direct deposit form from your bank for the first day of class (if you are selected for the program). This means if you do not have a bank account, you must have a valid ID to open an account.
